

Dear prospective families,

For the 2024-2025 school year, our organization is deciding between two pathways: 1) remain a homeschool enrichment program, or 2) convert to a private school. We will announce a decision by March 1st.

Private schools can accept the Opportunity Scholarship. Therefore, we are encouraging all current and interested families to **apply in February** (<https://www.ncseaa.edu/k12/opportunity>) in case we make the switch. Below is a comparison of both pathways so that you know what to expect in either direction.

	Pathway 1: Remain a Homeschool Enrichment Program	Pathway 2: Convert to a Private School
2024-2025 Tuition	\$5,500	\$7,700
Parent Responsibility	Maintain a homeschool, keep track of attendance, administer annual testing, serve as student's primary teacher, help with homework	Help with homework
Creation Acre Responsibility	Offer enrichment classes in various subjects while maintaining a secondary teaching role, after parents	Keep track of attendance, administer annual testing, serve as student's primary teacher
Financial Aid Options	None	Opportunity Scholarship, Creation Acre Scholarship (if not awarded Opportunity Scholarship)
School Days	Similar to this year, 116 days	Closer to 180 days with Fridays most likely being a work-at-home day and/or educational outings, exact days TBD
School Hours	Similar to this year, 8:45-1:45	8:30-2:45, exact hours TBD
Options for Homeschool Students	The whole program would be for homeschoolers, as it is now.	A selection of weekly a la carte enrichment classes for homeschoolers to periodically join the full-time private school students

We are prayerfully weighing each option, factoring in both long-term sustainability and building upon the wonderful culture we have created in our first year.
